Case managers are recognized experts and vital participants in the care coordination team. They empower patients to understand and access quality, efficient healthcare. Case managers provide facilitation between the client, family, health team, and payer.

The Growing Demand for Case Managers

The Affordable Care Act (ACA) continues to shape healthcare. The changes are both exciting and daunting and create a significant increase in demand for qualified Case Managers. Here are just a few of the things driving the increased demand:

- A **25 percent increase** in Hospital Case Manager Full Time Equivalent — per the 2013 National Hospital Case Management survey.¹
- A **26.7 percent increase** in Accountable Care Organizations (ACOs) in January 2015—per the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services.²
- **Surge in the number of newly insured** under the ACA needing patient advocates to educate people about their health plan benefits.³

Lastly, an estimated **44 percent of existing Case Managers** are age 56 and up— per the January 2015 Commission for Case Manager Certification Survey. Based on this data, an influx in demand to fill the positions of retirees can be expected.⁴

Application Requirements

- Baccalaureate in nursing from an accredited US College or University (RNs with degrees in other fields will be evaluated individually)
- Current RN licensure in an approved state where you reside and where your clinical placement will be done
- Clinical practice experience, 12 months is preferred, not required
- Goal statement
- Two letters of reference
- Successful completion of a statistics course with a grade of C or better
- Additional coursework may be required
- US Citizen or Permanent Resident
- TOEFL —The need for TOEFL will be assessed based on information provided by applicants on the application for admission, if required, a minimum score of 100 (internet based test) must be achieved and official score results must be provided.
